On July 31, 2002, the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit determined that it did not have jurisdiction to review the decisions of the district court that denied the transfer of tens of thousands of asbestos-related tort

claims, as well as its order to remand those tort claims to the state courts where they were originally filed. Because the Court of Appeals mandate has likewise issued, it is now appropriate for this Court to remand all of the friction product cases transferred to the United States District Court for the District of Delaware to the state courts where they were originally filed. Therefore,


