### **Position Description**

Chief Judge Stark is seeking a law clerk to assist him in all types of cases, with a focus on patent cases and particular emphasis on claim construction. Prior litigation experience or a clerkship is strongly preferred, as are excellent writing and research skills. This newly-created position will become available in October 2015 and has an initial term of one year, renewable depending upon satisfactory performance. Interested, qualified applicants are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.

### **Qualifications**

For consideration, applicants must be law school graduates with excellent writing and research skills. Prior litigation experience or a clerkship is strongly preferred. To qualify for a JSP 12, applicant must have one year of legal experience and bar membership. For a JSP 13, applicant must have two years of legal experience and bar membership. And for a JSP 14, applicant must have bar membership and three years of legal experience, two of which have been served in the Judiciary as a law clerk. Salary is determined based on experience.
