
ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Pursuant to a Memorandum of Understanding between this Court and the Delaware Department of Justice, and effective for habeas corpus petitions pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 filed after January 1, 2014, service of process shall be done via electronic means, namely via an email Notice of Service through the Court's CM/ECF system. Once service is ordered by the Court, the Delaware Department of Justice will receive the email notification of the Order to Respond/Answer and the corresponding Notice of Service, and be given a specified period of time, normally forty-five (45) days, within which to file a response.
