
ORDER

At Wilmington this 30th day of June, 2014,

IT IS ORDERED that:

Pursuant to a Memorandum of Understanding between this Court and the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Delaware, a one-year pilot program, beginning June 30, 2014, and effective for any complaint instituted by a plaintiff proceeding *in forma pauperis* pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915 against the Commissioner of Social Security in which the only claim is being brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), and seeking review of the denial of Social Security Disability Insurance benefits or Supplemental Security Income, service of the complaint shall be done via electronic notification, namely via entry of a "Service and Scheduling Order" through the Court's CM/ECF system. Once the Service and Scheduling Order is entered, the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Delaware will receive notice via a designated email account and will be given a specified time to answer or otherwise respond to the complaint.
