ORDER

At Wilmington this 3rd day of **December, 2008**.

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2008, this Court entered a Memorandum Order granting the request of Emerald Equipment Leasing, Inc. (“Emerald”) for the imposition of sanctions and ordering Mr. Timothy Armstrong, an attorney for Sea Star Line, LLC (“Sea Star”), to pay to Emerald the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) (the “Order”) (D.I. 213);

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2008, this Court entered an Order (D.I. 219) granting the Motion of Sea Star Line LLC to Extend Time (D.I. 217), thereby extending the deadline for payment of any sanctions as specified in the Court’s Order until ten (10) days after the entry of an order by Judge Farnan ruling on Sea Star’s Objections and Motion to Vacate or Set Aside Memorandum Order Regarding Sanctions (the “Objections”) (D.I. 218);

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2008, Judge Farnan entered a Memorandum Order (the “Memorandum Order”) (D.I. 231) overruling and denying Sea Star’s Objections.

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2008, Sea Star filed a Motion Pursuant to Local Rule


7.1.5 for Rehearing and Reargument of the Memorandum Order Regarding Sanctions (the “Motion to Reconsider”) (D.I. 233);

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2008, Sea Star also filed a Motion to Extend Time (the “Second Extension Motion”) (D.I. 234), requesting the entry of an order extending the deadline for the payment of sanctions specified in this Court’s Order until thirty (30) days after the entry of an order by Judge Farnan ruling on Sea Star’s Motion to Reconsider.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, having not found good cause to grant the relief requested, the Second Extension Motion (D.I. 234) is DENIED. The arguments in opposition to imposing sanctions have been heard and rejected on two occasions.

IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER ORDERED that payment of the sanctions is due no later than December 8, 2008.

Delaware counsel are reminded of their obligations to inform out-of-state counsel of this Order.
