This report contains the results of the General Chemistry examinations.

Results of Examinations:

The Item 1 pouch had minimal white/off-white solid residue adhered to the interior side of the flap and the bottom interior. Samples were collected from each area and combined for testing. Cocaine was identified within the Item 1 residue that was sampled and examined.

Item 1 was examined by the following techniques: visual examination, direct analysis in real time/time-of-flight mass spectrometry, and gas chromatography/mass spectrometry.
