
**STANDING ORDER REGARDING
BRIEFING IN NON-PATENT CASES**

WHEREAS, Judge Connolly's form scheduling order for non-patent civil cases was updated on May 21, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the May 21, 2019 revised form order sets forth various provisions regarding briefing, case dispositive motions, papers filed under seal, hard copies, motions in limine, and word limitations,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this 18th day of June 2019 that:

The provisions regarding briefing, case dispositive motions, papers filed under seal, hard copies, motions in limine, and word limitations set forth in the May 21, 2019 revised form order for non-patent cases shall apply in IN ALL NON-PATENT CIVIL CASES in which the parties are represented by counsel, regardless of when the case was filed, and specifically including: (1) cases in which the Court has already entered a Scheduling Order; and (2) cases in which a Scheduling Order has not yet been entered and a party seeks to file a motion to dismiss, motion for a preliminary injunction, or other filing before the entry of a Scheduling Order.
