STANDARD VOIR DIRE [NON-PATENT]

1. *Judge will read a brief description of the case.*

Is any member of the panel familiar with the case or has any member of the panel heard or read anything about it?

2. *Judge will ask counsel to introduce themselves.*

Have you or any member of your family had any business dealings with any of the attorneys or their law firms?

3. *Judge will ask counsel to introduce the parties and name any witnesses they expect to call.*

Do any members of the panel know the parties or any of the witnesses?

4. If you are selected to sit on this case, will you be able to render a verdict solely on the evidence presented at the trial and in the context of the law as I will give it to you in my instructions, disregarding any other ideas, notions, or beliefs about the law that you may have in reaching your verdict?

5. Do you have any special disability or problem that would make it difficult or impossible for you to serve as a member of the jury?

6. On most days, jurors will be expected to sit from 9:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. There will be a one-hour lunch break and a 15 minute break in the morning and afternoon. This case is expected to take ___ days to try so that we expect the testimony in the trial will be completed by _____. Is there any member of the panel who would be

unable to sit as a juror in the case for that period of time?

Voir Dire as submitted by the parties

Limited to four (4) questions from each side. The questions should be designed to ***elicit a yes or no answer***.
