

IT IS ORDERED that:

Pursuant to a Memorandum of Understanding among this Court, the Delaware Department of Correction, and the Delaware Department of Justice, the parties have agreed to extend the e-service program, effective March 1, 2016, for *pro se* complaints filed by individuals against the Delaware Department of Correction and/or its current or former employees, service of the complaint shall be done via electronic notification, namely via entry of an “Service Order” through the Court’s CM/ECF system. Once the Service Order is entered, the Delaware Department of Correction and/or the Delaware Department of Justice will receive notice via designated email account(s) and will be given a specified time to file a waiver of service executed or a waiver of service unexecuted, and a specific time to answer or otherwise respond to the complaint upon the filing of a waiver of service executed.
