ORDER

The Court's December 15, 2006 Order concerning the scheduling of non-case dispositive motion in patent cases is modified as follows:

- I. Any non-case dispositive motion, along with an Opening Brief, shall be filed with a Notice of Motion.
- II.
 - a) The Notice of Motion shall designate the date the movant seeks to present the motion..
 - b) Briefing shall be in accordance with the Federal and Local Rules. The Court will not order expedited briefing.
 - c) The final brief submitted shall be filed no later than 12:00 noon the Friday before the motion day on which it is to be heard.
 - d) The Court will regularly post the available motion days on the internet at:

- III. Upon filing of the Notice of Motion a copy of said Notice should be sent to chambers at: jjf_civil@ded.uscourts.gov.
- IV. At the motion hearing, a total of twenty (20) minutes will be allocated for argument on each motion with said time being shared by each side equally.
