ORDERED that all grand jury sessions are suspended through May 22, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that as to the computation of time for the filing of an

information or indictment as set forth in 18 U.S.C. § 3161(b), the period of time from April 28,

2020 through the earlier of May 22, 2020 or the date the next grand jury reconvenes is deemed

excludable delay under the Speedy Trial Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7)(A), as the Court finds that

the ends of justice served by taking this action outweigh the interests of the parties and the public

in a speedy trial.
