<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREAS effective July 14, 2025 the Attorney General appointed Julianne Murray under 28 U.S.C. § 546(a) to serve as the interim United States Attorney for the District of Delaware;

WHEREAS under § 546(c), Ms. Murray may not serve as the interim United States Attorney for the District of Delaware beyond the earlier of (1) the appointment by the President with the advice and consent of the Senate of a United States Attorney for the District of Delaware or (2) 120 days after Ms. Murray's appointment by the Attorney General on July 14, 2025 (i.e., November 11, 2025);

WHEREAS the President has not nominated a person to be considered by the Senate to serve as the United States Attorney for the District for Delaware;

WHEREAS under § 546(d), if a United States Attorney for the District of Delaware is not nominated by the President and confirmed by the Senate by November 11, 2025, the Court "may appoint a United States attorney to serve until the vacancy is filled";

WHEREAS in the event the President does not appoint with the advice and consent of the Senate a United States Attorney for the District of Delaware before November 11, 2025 and the Court decides to appoint a United States Attorney to

serve until the vacancy is filled, the Court would appoint only a person the Court

deems qualified for that position; and

WHEREAS November 11, 2025 is less than two months away;

NOW THEREFORE, at Wilmington on this Seventeenth day of September

in 2025, it is HEREBY ORDERED that if a person wishes to be considered by the

Court for possible appointment by the Court under § 546(d) as the United States

Attorney for the District of Delaware effective November 11, 2025, that person

shall complete and submit to the Clerk of the Court no later than October 7, 2025

the Application for Court-Appointed United States Attorney Position posted on the

Court's website.
