ORDER APPOINTING MERIT SELECTION PANEL

WHEREAS, the current term of office of United States Magistrate Judge Sherry R. Fallon at Wilmington, Delaware is due to expire on April 24, 2020, and the United States District Court is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of the Magistrate Judge to a new eight-year term;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 631 and § 6.03 of the Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED that:

2. The Merit Selection Panel shall proceed forthwith to undertake the duties and responsibilities as provided by statute and regulations as hereinbefore provided, and review the incumbent's current service as Magistrate Judge and other experience, the comments from members of the bar and public, and other evidence of the incumbent's good character, ability, and commitment to equal justice under the law.

3. All Panel members have been advised in writing of the restriction set forth in §420.30.20(d) of the Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States Establishing Standards and Procedures for the Appointment and Reappointment of United States Magistrate Judges.

4. The Panel shall report to the Court within ninety days after its creation on August 19, 2019, unless otherwise directed by the Court, whether the incumbent is recommended for reappointment.

5. Public notice shall be posted in appropriate public facilities describing the duties of the position, the date of expiration of the incumbent's current term of office, and invite comments from members of the public. The notice shall include the name and address of the person to whom comments shall be submitted.
