
**STANDING ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that:

Pursuant to a Memorandum of Understanding between this Court and Centurion of Delaware, LLC, the parties have agreed to extend the e-service program, effective November 18, 2022, for *pro se* complaints filed by prisoners against Centurion Defendant. Service of the complaint shall be done via electronic notification, namely via entry of a “Service Order” through the Court’s CM/ECF system. Once the Service Order is entered, Centurion of Delaware, LLC will receive notice via designated email account(s) and will be given a specified time to file a waiver of service executed or a waiver of service unexecuted, and a specific time to answer or otherwise respond to the complaint upon the filing of a waiver of service executed.
