## ORDER

The above-captioned case, which is stayed and administratively closed, is UNSTAYED and REOPENED.

The Court has reviewed the proposals for how to proceed and related commentary. (D.I. 79-84). The case was stayed by stipulation in 2014. (D.I. 14). At the time, Defendant had filed a motion to dismiss. (D.I. 5). The accompanying briefing (D.I. 6, 9, 10) was based on the law as it was at the time, and it was scattershot inasmuch as four patents were then at issue. Now only one asserted patent remains. The Court has considered Defendant's request for supplemental briefing (D.I. 84) but does not believe that would be helpful. What would be helpful is rebriefing. The earlier briefing will not be considered. The Court will consider a renewed motion to dismiss and brief in support which shall be due no later than fourteen (14) days from the date this Order is filed.

IT IS SO ORDERED this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 2020. A separate order will be entered setting a schedule after the motion to dismiss is resolved.
