At Wilmington, this 27th day of August, 2020, for the reasons set forth in the Memorandum Opinion issued this date:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Petitioner Samuel D. Turner’s Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 1 in Civ. A. No. 17-722-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because

Turner has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

2. Petitioner Curtis Finney's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 1 in Civ. A. No. 17-723-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Finney has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

3. Petitioner Eugenia Watson's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-732-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Watson has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

4. Petitioner George R. Dorsey's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-772-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Dorsey has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

5. Petitioner Tymere Dorsett's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-789-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Dorsett has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

6. Petitioner Jamil Bailey's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-790-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Bailey has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

7. Petitioner Laron Carney's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-791-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested

therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Carney has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

8. Petitioner Neal Gibson's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 3 in Civ. A. No. 17-793-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Gibson has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

9. Petitioner Lamonte Harrigan's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-863-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Harrigan has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

10. Petitioner Davern Laws' Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-864-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Laws has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

11. Petitioner James Humphrey's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-898-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Humphrey has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

12. Petitioner Bernard Herring's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-904-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Herring has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

13. Petitioner Tavar Smith's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to

28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-1141-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Smith has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

14. Petitioner Thomas Rothwell's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-1158-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Rothwell has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

15. Petitioner Jamal Johnson's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-1195-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Johnson has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

16. Petitioner Luis Rivera's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A. No. 17-1233-RGA) is **DISMISSED**, and the relief requested therein is **DENIED**. The Court declines to issue a certificate of appealability because Rivera has failed to satisfy the standards set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2).

17. Petitioner Jyaire Smith's Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (D.I. 2 in Civ. A.
